The MISA test is part of our state testing requirements and students will receive scores. Historically, our school has not done as well on MISA as we do on Math and Reading tests so 5th grade will begin reviewing for MISA this week!


Star Lab at Woodbridge March 4 – 12th

Star lab is a mobile planetarium that BCPS central office science teachers take from school to school. It visits once every 2-3 years and this year it is coming back to Woodbridge. Students will receive astronomy instruction from their classroom teachers then have an opportunity to experience what they learned inside of the Star Lab. This is always a huge hit. Be sure to ask your child about their Star Lab experience!



What Will Virtual Learning Look Like

Google Meet at home to receive synchronous instruction. Here is what you can expect. When we suspect there may be a virtual learning day, your child will bring their fully charged device home with them from school. The teachers are sending home a schedule that tells you what the google meet codes will be and when children have instruction, independent work, special, lunch and recess so you can plan for student supervision. Students can also log in through a phone if they sign in with their google account or the teacher sends a direct link. Please watch for specific information from the teacher to come home soon.
