

New DEVICES from BCPS Important: Students will be charged \$355 for intentional damage

Destruction and/or vandalism of school property is a Category II offense. This includes the destruction of technological devices. The student's responsible use of technology/internet is described in the 2023-2024 BCPS Student Handbook.

Specifically, it indicates that students shall be held responsible for the appropriate use of BCPS technology and will be subject to disciplinary action for any violation of the Technology Acceptable Use Policy (TAUP). Students are required to be safe, secure, and responsible digital citizens when using BCPS electronic devices, networks, and the internet.

Acknowledgment of the Student Handbook indicates that students agree to the following: Protecting school property and understanding that vandalism is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, accessing, modifying, or destroying equipment, programs, files, or settings on any computer or technology resource.

Changes to Award Criteria

You received a flyer outlining the Woodbridge Award Criteria for the 23-24 school year in your Back to School folder.



Unfortunately, BCPS made a slight change to report card criteria *after* those papers were completed.

Now, there are 4 points in the Learning Skills and Conduct area on the report card which means instead of students earning all 3's to qualify for an award, they must earn ALL 4's in those areas. Learning Skills and Conduct include things like attendance and ontime arrival, completing homework and classwork, working well with peers and adults and following classroom routines and procedures. If you have any questions about Woodbridge Award Criteria, please ask your child's teacher or call us in the office.

Awards will be distributed twice a year (at the end of the 1st semester and at the end of the year). We look forward to celebrating your child's accomplishments with you!

Field Trips are FUN!

It is Field Trip season already! Every grade, including PreKindergarten, will take at least 2 field trips this year, one in the fall and one in the Spring. If you would like to chaperone a field trip, you MUST complete the Volunteer application and training. This must be completed EVERY year. Go to bcps.org; select Parent; select "Family and Community Engagement" from the drop down menu; select "BCPS Volunteers" from the side menu and follow the directions to complete both the application and training. Send the application and training certificate to school or email Ms. Jen (jlee4@bcps.org). Complete the "I want to chaperone" form and send it to the teacher. Once your paperwork is confirmed, you will be contacted to send in the money required for the trip. Once those steps are complete, then you can ask for the day off from work to go.

Chaperone numbers are limited based on available bus space so please do not take off work until the teacher confirms that you will be a chaperone!!


